Public Content

The City of Sterling was awarded an IHDA Strong Communities Program grant in the amount of \$246,400 to assist with the renovation and demolition of certain residential properties. A condition of the grant award is an approval of a Conditional Commitment Letter which must be signed by the Mayor and returned to IHDA by February 1, 2021.

The attached ordinance authorizes the Mayor to sign the Conditional Commitment Letter. Once returned, IHDA will follow with a Program Funding Agreement.
